



Information Regarding the Pupil Development Grant

The pupil deprivation grant supports the Welsh Government's national priorities for all schools. The priority of the pupil deprivation grant (PDG) is to reduce the impact of poverty on educational attainment.

The Welsh government has stated that each individual school is able to decide how it spends its allocation of money to best improve attainment.

The total number of pupils on school roll for September 2019 is 77.5 FTE (Full Time Equivalent – Nursery pupils who attend our morning nursery are counted as ½) pupils. The school's Free School Meal (FSM) population is around 5%. This is greater than the figure the year when the allocation was calculated.

The total allocation of PDG to this school for April 2019 to March 2020 is £1150.

Linking with the 'Transformational Curriculum', the funding will be used to help fund the nurture and intervention groups such as 'THRIVE' that the school runs in order to support the wellbeing of key groups of children.

The school's PDG and EIG Plans are regularly scrutinised by the Governing Body, supported by advice from the Education Achievement Service and monitored by the Local Authority.
